

Faith in Action Merton Homelessness Project: Merton Drop-in personnel

STAFF

1 Manager, 4.5 days week.

1 Senior Project worker, 3 days week.

1 Project Worker, 2 days week

3 Polish-speaking workers, currently providing a total of 7 days' work per week

1 New Opportunities Worker (employment, training, volunteering), 2 days week.

VOLUNTEERS

Roughly 50 volunteers in the Drop-In. Most volunteer for 1 day per week, Wednesday or Friday.

One volunteer comes in both days.

Wednesday and Friday teams:

Each have about eight people who cook and serve food, two who look after the showers and laundry, and other people are 'front of house', covering reception and assisting service users.

Several Trustees also volunteer in the Drop-In.

VISITING WORKERS

WDP, Merton Drug & Alcohol treatment team. 1 afternoon a week.

Merton Rough Sleepers team. Usually visit on a Wednesday.

Rough Sleepers London Mental Health Assessment Worker. When requested.

DWP Outreach Worker. Visits on a Wednesday.

Ursuline School volunteers, up to four students. On a Wednesday afternoon.

Currently the Merton Covid response team 1 day a week.

Haircuts for Homeless, recommencing monthly visits.
